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SAFER HAIR DYES

The main ingredient in hair dyes that causes reactions is called paraphenylenediamine (ppda). Please look for it in your current dye. It may not have the same name, but something similar. The dyes listed below still can react, but less chances of this happening than with your previous hair dye that has ppda.

Hair dye reactions can worsen with each exposure. The reaction can last weeks to months. Please try to avoid using even these safer dyes until <u>at least</u> 3 months after the original hair dye reaction has cleared up.

If a reaction occurs, even with these safer dyes, you <u>must</u> stop using them.
